NOTICE OF NOMINATION

Public Notice is given to the electors of the Cariboo Regional District that nominations for the office of Director for each of Electoral Areas “A”, “B”, “C”, “D”, “E”, “F”, “G”, “H”, “I”, “J”, “K” and “L” for a 3-year term commencing in December 2011 will be received by the Chief Election Officer or Deputy Chief Election Officer, at the Cariboo Regional District Office in Williams Lake between the hours of 9:00 am on Tuesday, October 4, 2011 and 4:00 pm on Friday, October 14, 2011, excluding Statutory holidays and weekends.

Nomination documents are available at the Cariboo Regional District offices in Williams Lake, 100 Mile House and Quesnel during regular office hours, noted below.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or from being nominated for, being elected to, or holding office.
